Single Sheet Prints (on the EPSON 4000)

- 1. Go to the printer you wish to use and make sure you set the "Page Size" to the size of the paper you are using
- 2. Set up your print in the same manner as before
- 3. Make sure to check under the "Preview and Size" tab under the "Maximum Print Area" and that it is showing the appropriate paper size
- 4. Once the print has processed, click on it to highlight it, then right click on go to **Edit > Printer Settings**
 - -Under "Media Type" make sure that you choose the appropriate paper type and (sheet)
 - -Then choose either Manual or Tray
 - -Turn the **Auto Cut** off

Nozzle Check

For PC

- 1. Go to Start -> Settings -> Printer and Faxes
- 2. Choose the printer (make sure you choose the local printer, for example: if I want to clean the 7600 I would choose "EPSON Stylus Pro 7600", NOT the one with UltraChroma after it, it is easy to tell by the icons, the local printer looks like a printer and the networked printer looks like a hand supporting the printer)
- 3. Double click on the printer, then go to **Printer -> Printing Preferences**
- 4. Go to the "Utility" tab and choose Nozzle Check
- 5. Click **Print**, once it has finished printing evaluate it for gaps, if there are gaps hit "**clean**" and then print again, repeat this process until all the gaps are gone
